The Role

The company is seeking a Product Development Scientist to join the team, with the role of:

- Primarily conceiving & developing products for the packaging industry by formulating resin systems to give desired performance as a coating for fibre based products (e.g. paper and paperboard). By optimising, for example:
 - o Barrier properties, mechanical properties, shelf-life, cost
- Developing concepts and ideas into robust Xampla products compatible with upstream/downstream processing and market expectations
- Planning, designing and executing R&D projects with the support of the senior team
- Leveraging understanding of Xampla technology and materials science concepts to design high performance, real-world products
- Using materials science/chemistry knowledge and knowhow to support other technical projects within the wider R&D group
- Confidently reporting results back to the Product Development/R&D team,
 wider Xampla stakeholders and occasionally external partners/customers
- Designing and undertaking experiments. Collecting, organising and analysing experimental data. Ensuring proper documentation and traceability using internal systems
- Working collaboratively with Applications and Business Development teams to understand the needs of product design
- Working collaboratively with the Process Development Team to align product properties with scale-up capabilities & downstream processing, identifying areas for optimisation
- Assisting the Lab Manager in keeping the Lab in a safe and efficient order, including writing documents such as procedure, risk assessments etc. with basic equipment maintenance performed where appropriate
- Occasionally supporting ad hoc activities within the wider R&D group

The Product Development team, part of the wider R&D group, bridges the gap between Research & Innovation and the Applications and Business Development teams.

The team works on a variety of applications with a particular focus of this role being on the development and application of Xampla's proprietary plant-based coating technology for the packaging industry.
